The first Primary election for Nebraska was held September 20th, 1907, Nebraska being among the first States in the Union to provide this method of nominating candidates to public office. The Primary Law has been amended from time to time, but is yet a subject for criticism.

This pamphlet contains information which will be found to be of great advantage to the student of political history, and is the first time anything of the nature has been attempted in this state.
