REPORTED PROBLEMS AND ERRORS

Butler County: Issue of Retention of Workers Compensation Court Judge James Coe did not appear on the ballot. Number of ballots impacted was 3905. Margin of retention was 191,637. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Jefferson County: Issues of Retention of Supreme Court Justice William Connolly and Court of Appeals Judge Everett O. Inbody, II did not appear on the ballot. Number of ballots impacted was 3478. Margin of retention was 39,632 for Supreme Court Justice Connolly and 35,374 for Court of Appeals Judge Inbody. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Hayes County: Issues of Retention of Supreme Court Justice John F. Wright and Court of Appeals Judge Wesley C. Mues did not appear on the ballot. Number of ballots impacted was 534. Margin of retention was 34,109 for Supreme Court Justice Wright and 32,892 for Court of Appeals Judge Mues. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Merrick County: (1) Central Community College District #4 election did not appear on the ballot. Candidate Don Anderson was the only name to appear on the ballot although a write in line would have been available. Number of ballots impacted was 3,131. Margin of victory was at least 10,745. Outcome was not affected by the error.

(2) Educational Service Unit #10 ballot read "Vote for One" rather than the proper "Vote for Four". Number of ballots impacted was 210. Margin between fourth and fifth position was 1,427. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Pawnee County: (1) Southeast Community College District #3 election did not appear on the ballot. Candidate Leo J. Kelly was the only name to appear on the ballot although a write in line would have been available. Number of ballots impacted was 1629. Margin of victory was at least 15,888. Outcome was not affected by the error.

(2) In Omaha Public Power District, South Subdivision election, ballots were not provided to voters of several villages that were eligible to vote. Number of ballots impacted was 271. Margin of victory was 2832. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Polk County: In Polk County Rural Public Power District, Subdivision One election, pollworkers provided ballots to 121 residents of the Village of Shelby who were ineligible to vote in the race. Election was a "Vote for Three" and only three candidates appeared on the ballot. No write in line is provided for public power district elections. Outcome was not affected by the error.

Sioux County: Issue of Retention of Workers Compensation Court Judge Ron Brown did not appear on the ballot. Number of ballots impacted was 808. Margin of retention was 206,784. Outcome was not affected by the error.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 1

A constitutional amendment to provide that no person shall be denied the equal protection of the laws.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2, PART A

A constitutional amendment to change a restriction on allocation of proceeds from motor vehicle taxes.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2, PART B

A constitutional amendment to authorize legislation relating to mergers and consolidations by local governments.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2, PART C

A constitutional amendment to provide that property of the state and its governmental subdivisions is exempt from taxation to the extent such property is used for public purposes and to authorize classification and taxation of property not used for authorized public purposes.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2, PART D

A constitutional amendment to repeal and eliminate provisions dealing with township organization and towns.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 3, PART A

A constitutional amendment to change residence and office requirements for the Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme Court.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 3, PART B

A constitutional amendment to provide for the retention of judges of the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on a statewide basis.

PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION MEASURE 413

A constitutional amendment to limit government spending by limiting tax revenue increases by state and local governments. Tax revenue increases would be limited to the rate of inflation, population growth, costs of temporary emergencies, and new unfunded federal mandates. Voters may elect to exceed the limit. Property tax rates or sales and income tax rates would be reduced if projected local or state tax revenues exceed the increase permitted. Taxes above the limit would be returned through reduced tax rates. After five years, the Legislature, by three-fourths vote, and with the Governor's approval, may suspend the limit.

PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION MEASURE 414

An amendment to Nebraska Statutes to require the Public Service Commission to set access charges imposed by local telephone carriers for access to local telephone networks based upon forward-looking economic costs without implicit subsidies; require that average, aggregate prices charged to consumers for long distance service within the state reflect the reduction in access charges applicable to that service; require that local exchange access be cost-based, competitively neutral, and non-discriminatory; and develop competition in the telephone access service marketplace.
