### **Enhanced web application available to Nebraska voters on mobile devices**

LINCOLN – A newly enhanced web application may help provide Nebraska voters with critical information, in the weeks leading up to the general election. It is part of Voter View on the Secretary of State’s website, a system that allows voters to check their registration, request an early ballot, find the location of their polling place and check the status of their provisional ballot.

“This really is a handy tool,” said Sec. John Gale. “Previously, users would have needed access to a computer to log on and see this information. With this mobile feature they can find out where they need to vote while they’re at work or when trying to get there on Election Day.”

When users access the website using their mobile device, they should be automatically redirected to the mobile-friendly page. If it does not redirect due to phone settings, users can still access the mobile site through the Voter View Mobile link at the bottom of the webpage.

The address for the website is: <https://www.votercheck.necvr.ne.gov>. Users can also get there by logging onto the Secretary of State’s main website [www.sos.ne.gov](http://www.sos.ne.gov) and selecting the “Elections” tab at the top of the page. That will bring up a new set of tabs, including the “Voter Information Center” which is the home of Voter View.

“We recognize that while a lot of people may not have access to a computer when they’re trying to figure out their voter information, chances are, they still have a

mobile device handy," Gale explained. "Hopefully, this will provide voters with the information they're in need of before and on Election Day.
