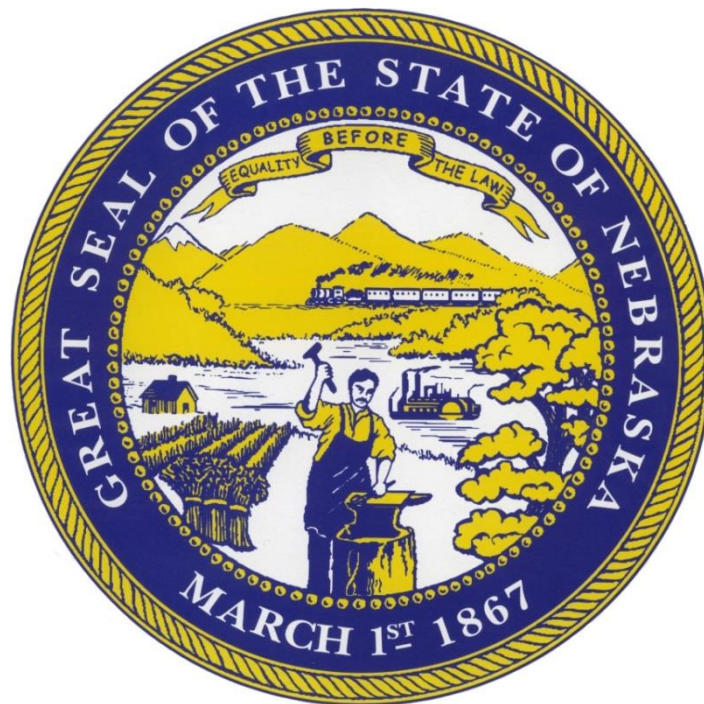

STATE OF NEBRASKA

This is the 54th Edition of the Primary Election Canvass Book that has been published in this state, and it is the second primary during my tenure as Nebraska's 27th Secretary of State and Chief Elections Official.

The 2022 election cycle started off with an unprecedented event. For the first time in history, the U.S. Census Bureau was late in providing census data. Redistricting, already a cumbersome process occurring only once every ten years, was made even more difficult.

The Census Act requires the Secretary of Commerce to deliver population data to the states by April 1, 2021, per 13 U.S.C. § 141. However, population data was not delivered until August 12, 2021, over four months after the deadline. Some states had constitutional conflicts with this late delivery, however, Nebraska was slightly more fortunate to have only statutory conflicts.

My office worked on a revised timeline, and necessarily statutory changes via LB285, with representatives from a wide range of political subdivisions in order to facilitate a smooth 2022 election cycle while still meeting redistricting obligations. The Nebraska Legislature convened in special session on September 13, 2021, and new redistricting maps were approved by the Governor on September 30, 2021. Our 93 counties started revising precincts on October 1 and delivered final precinct maps to political subdivisions by November 1. Political subdivisions throughout the state then redistricted, attempting to follow precinct lines as closely as possible, and provided updated election boundaries to county election offices by December 30, 2021. Finally, county election officials implemented those new boundary lines prior to finalizing ballot layout in March 2022.

I am very grateful for the hard work and flexibility of our Nebraska Legislature, the Legislative Research Office, county election officials, and political subdivisions in ensuring a successful post-redistricting primary election.
