Judges Up for Retention

Pursuant to Neb. Const. [V-21\(3\)](#), judges are required to file for retention at the first general election following the expiration of 3 years from the date of their appointment and every 6 years thereafter.


Judges up for retention must file retention requests with the Secretary of State's office by August 3, 2026. Judges up for retention will be certified to the county election official by the Secretary of State's office for the general election ballot.




