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Secretary of State certifies Mark Cohen's U.S. House of Representatives petition

The Nebraska Secretary of State's office announced today that Mark Cohen has fulfilled the statutory requirements to appear as a nonpartisan candidate for U.S. House of Representatives in Congressional District 3 on the 2026 general election ballot.

Cohen's campaign collected at least 2,207 valid signatures from registered Nebraska voters in Nebraska's third congressional district. The Secretary of State's office concluded signature verification after the number of valid signatures met the 110% threshold as permitted in [Nebraska Revised Statute § 32-618](#).

To be placed on the ballot by petition as a candidate for U.S House of Representatives, 2,000 valid signatures are required from registered voters in the applicable district.

In November 2025, the Secretary of State's office authorized for circulation of Cohen's petition for Congressional District 3 in Nebraska. On July 30, the campaign returned completed petitions to the Secretary of State's office.

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
