Create an election Integrity Judicial Panel through a constitutional amendment.

Article V of the Constitution of Nebraska shall be amended by adding a new section 32 as shown:

An election integrity panel of three judges shall be formed. The judges shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by a simple majority of the Legislature.

Membership on the panel will consist of one individual from the geographic west of the State using any counties which have geographical territory west of the western boundary of Custer County; one individual from the geographic center of the State using any counties which have geographic territory east of the western boundary of Custer County or west of the eastern boundary of York County; and one individual from the geographic east of the State using any counties which have geographic territory east of the eastern boundary of York County. At least one of these individuals shall be an appellate court judge or an attorney from the Revisor of Statutes office.

The panel shall be self-administering, establishing its own operating procedures for filing claims, deadlines for responses, standards of review and similar procedures.

Any or all candidates in an election occurring in Nebraska may participate in a proceeding before the panel regarding the election if any of the candidates in such election claim voter or election irregularities.

The term of office is from three months prior to the Nebraska primary elections until any and all cases before the panel are decided.

All case proceedings before the panel shall be decided before the Nebraska elections may be certified.

This amendment becomes operative on January 10, 2023.
