Canvas Board scheduled to certify results of the November 8, 2022, Statewide Elections

LINCOLN - Members of the Nebraska State Board of Canvassers will convene in the Governor's Hearing Room at the State Capitol at 11:00 am on Monday, December 5, 2022. The purpose of the meeting is to certify the results of the November 8, 2022, statewide general election.

The board consists of all state constitutional officers. The meeting is open to the public.

Once county canvassing boards have met and certified their results, local election officials submit the certified results from local, state, and federal races to the Secretary of State's office. Results will be compiled and presented to the State Board of Canvassers for final approval. Only results for offices filed through the Secretary of State are included in that report.

If any final certified results of a race fall within the parameters of an automatic recount, a second meeting of the Nebraska Board of State Canvassers is scheduled for Monday, December 12, 2022, at 11:00 am in the Governor's Hearing Room at the State Capitol in Lincoln, Nebraska.
